WRIT OF ELECTION

TO THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF LEFLORE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI:

The Circuit Court of Leflore County, Mississippi, held in *Anjuan Brown v. Preston Ratcliff, et al.*, No. 2011-0098CI, on November 18, 2011, that a special election shall be held to elect a Supervisor, District 3.

As a result, by virtue of the authority vested in me as acting Governor of the State of Mississippi by the provisions of Section 23-15-937, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and in accordance with the court decision cited above, I, William G. Hewes, III, acting Governor of the State of Mississippi, do hereby issue this Writ of Election, and hereby set December 20, 2011, as the date on which a special election shall be held in the above named county to elect a Supervisor, District 3. The candidates shall be Anjuan Brown, Charles McCain, and Preston Ratliff.

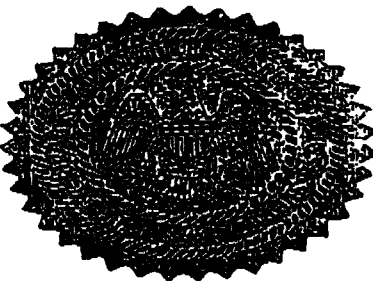
This special election shall be held and notice thereof shall be given in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Mississippi governing county special elections and the Circuit Court's ruling in *Anjuan Brown v. Preston Ratcliff, et al.*, No. 2011-0098CI. If a runoff election shall be required, it shall be held on January 10, 2012, in accordance with Section 23-15-833, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended. All relevant state laws not in conflict with the terms of this Writ of Election shall apply to this special election.

The Election Commissioners of Leflore County shall govern themselves accordingly.
