ORDER GRANTING A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This cause came on to be heard on the Application of Preston Ratliff seeking a Temporary Injunction against Defendants Latrinda Walker, Catherine Climons and Larry Griggs, to prevent them from conducting a hearing on his Petition To Contest Election pending before the Leflore County Democratic Executive Committee, on the Grounds that said Defendants have failed to give him five (5) days notice as required by Section 23-15-921 and Section 1-3-65, MCA as Amended (1972), and the Court having been fully advised in the premises does find that the Application shall be granted and finds that immediate and irreparable harm will result to the Applicant before the Defendants or their Attorney can be heard in opposition, and the Court is satisfied with reasons given by Applicant's Attorney that notice to Defendants should not be required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendants Latrinda Walker, Catherine Climons and Larry Griggs and anyone else acting on behalf of the Leflore County Democratic Executive Committee are hereby restrained from conducting a meeting or hearing on Preston Ratliff's Petition to Contest Election


which is set for hearing at noon on this date at the Leflore County Courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there shall be no hearing on the Petition to Contest Election until such time as the parties are given proper notice in accordance with Mississippi law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Motion for a Preliminary Injunction shall be set for hearing at 8:30 ^{Am} on September 8th, 2011 at the Leflore County Courthouse in Greenwood, Mississippi.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall give security or post security bond in the amount of \$100.00.
